

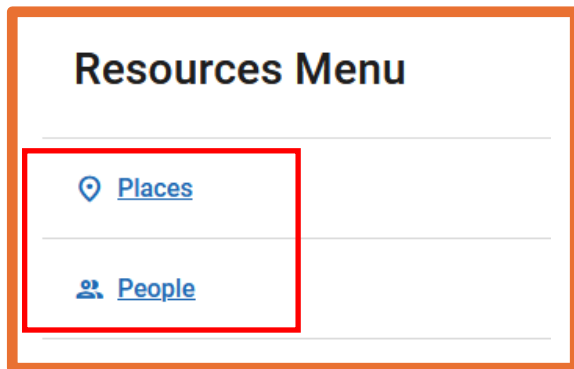
Navigate: Resources Feature

Resources is a directory that students use to learn about physical and digital resources critical to their success.


Where: Resources is a link on the **home page** for Navigate360 Student desktop and mobile.

The **People** page in Resources adds contact information **for assigned staff and faculty**. If your staff and faculty have entered pronouns, this shows on the People page.

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
